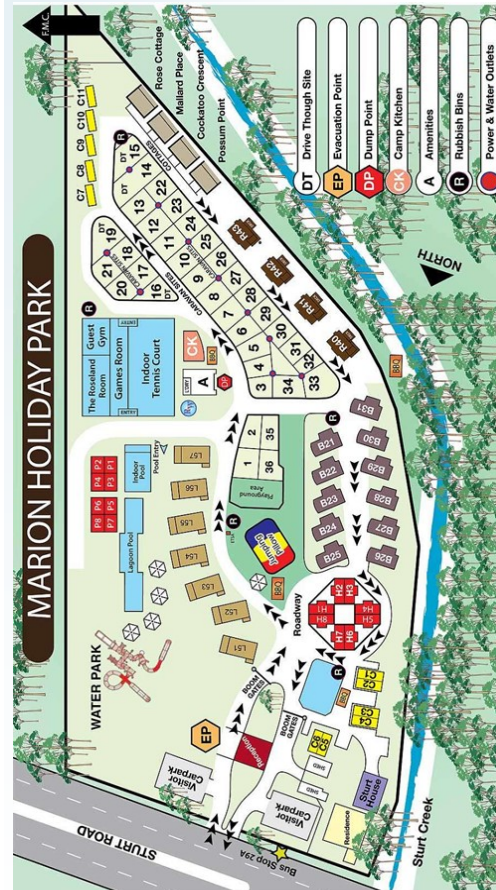
#3 Keep calm they're almost in bed. (to be confirmed)
